I am most disappointed, with regard to the above review you have failed to take into account the views of the community, accepting instead the views of a political party who are not interested in the well being of Bradley Stoke residents.

I fail to understand why you have ignored very valid reasons why there will be serious conflicts of interest for anyone representing this area, undoubtedly giving priority/weight to the Stoke Gifford majority and being a disbenefit to Bradley Stoke minority.

Your report, on page 36 paragraph 67, fails to reflect the strong feelings that have been expressed by the residents of Bradley Stoke against the proposals.

Having viewed your web site and the body of evidence opposing the proposals I find it difficult to accept that you have agreed to this proposal. An analysis of correspondence on this subject shows letters from "ordinary people" (non councillors) amount to 37 of which only 1 supports the proposals. The report indicates that there is a body of evidence that supports the proposals; where is it?
