Lancaster City Council Review of Ward Boundaries

At the Executive Committee of the Lancaster and Morecambe Liberal Democrats, which met on the 5th March 2013 consideration was given to the proposals made for the changes to the Lancaster City Council Ward Boundaries.

The committee were very much in agreement with removing the University Halls of Residence from the Ellel Ward into the University Ward but are concerned that the Parish of Scotforth has also been moved into this proposed 3 member ward. The parish has a very small electorate and has much closer community ties with the Parish of Quernmore. Should it not be moved into the Lower Lune Valley Ward. Before the last changes it was part of the Caton Ward that covered Caton, Quernmore and Scotforth Parishes. It has no community links with the University and would lose appropriate councillor representation from being part of a 3 member ward.

We also find that moving Warton Parish into the Carnforth Ward to make a 3 member ward is undesirable. Warton is a village with a community life of its own, Carnforth is a Market Town with a growing industrial sector. Warton would lose any proper councillor representation in a 3 member ward if these proposals are adopted.
