Warton Parish Council wishes to register a protest against the proposal that as part of the review of Lancaster District Council Wards the ward of Warton should be combined with the Carnforth ward. The rural nature of Warton is best served by the present grouping of villages to the north of Carnforth and not as an add on to an urban area.

Councillors are particularly annoyed by the proposal as they understand it was put forward as a means to even up district councillors work loads rather than to improve services to electors. At no time has our current district councillor complained about her workload and has delivered her responsibilities efficiently and within acceptable timescales. We understand the proposal would mean that the Warton ward would be served by any of three councillors elected to the district council to represent Carnforth rather than as at present one only with direct responsibility for the ward.

Councillors would ask that their views be taken into consideration when final proposals are agreed.
