Subject: Electoral Review of Bath and North East Somerset - Warding in the Parish of South Stoke

Dear sirs,

The Parish Council considered this matter at their meeting on Monday 25th September, in order to put forward Warding arrangements for the new development on the South Stoke Plateau. However, as it is not at all clear what the scope of the development will be, nor the timescale, we wish only to highlight the need for a later complementary local review when it is clear what populations will be in place.

The current proposals are for 173 new homes, and the illustrative master plan presented indicates the potential for a further development of a similar size. Since the number of dwellings in the current Parish are of the order of 170, the Parish might need to have up to three separate wards to represent these three possibly distinct areas.

It is not considered possible or desirable to anticipate the actual form of these developments when built, and so a later complementary review when it becomes clearer, probably when construction begins, is the only feasible way forward.
