Electoral Review of North Norfolk

Upper Sheringham Parish Council have asked me to submit their comments on proposals for the current review of ward boundaries.

They are very disappointed to be included in such a vast ward, the proposal is to be included in the Coastal Ward. This is a ward that stretches along the coast to Blakeney. Although the Parish does have a small coastline Upper Sheringham is not actually considered as a coastal community, as are many of the other Parishes in the new ward. Therefore many of the coastal issues of the ward will not necessarily apply to Upper Sheringham.

The Parish Council feel it would be much more appropriate to be included in a Sheringham ward as there are both historical links to Sheringham and similar local issues, which would be well served by the same District Councillor.

We hope you will take these points on board when making a final decision on the new boundaries.
