Dear Sir/ Madam,

Winterbourne Road is a strong ward boundary between Bradley Stoke Town and Stoke Gifford Parish and therefore its use should be limited between the Bradley Stoke South ward and Stoke Gifford ward (as is present) and should not be used at all as a boundary where the road becomes a dual carriageway. It is the main Winterbourne/Frampton Cotterell and Patchway/Filton from the opposite direction and is very busy at peak times. The dual carriageway section has a central reservation and wide grass verges either side. Only the current part of Bradley Stoke in the Stoke Gifford ward should remain there, and NO extra voters should be moved into the Stoke Gifford ward from Bradley Stoke. This will also remove any further additional confusion in the future, whereby residents are puzzled that while they live north of Winterbourne Road and in Bradley Stoke Town, they are actually represented by Stoke Gifford based SG Councillors who represent the Stoke Gifford Ward.

In Baileys Court Road the Town Council maintains the Baileys Court Activity Centre, a multi-purpose facility including a cricket club and bowls club and is one of the main centres for local residents. The LGBC proposal would place this at the edge of Bradley Stoke. We think that this facility should be located well within the boundary of Bradley Stoke South ward.

We support putting all of the Parish of Stoke Lodge and The Common into one ward, Bradley Stoke North and not divided between two different wards. This new parish was created by local popular demand and above any other parish in South Gloucestershire its needs to keep its identity and this is best done within a single ward.
