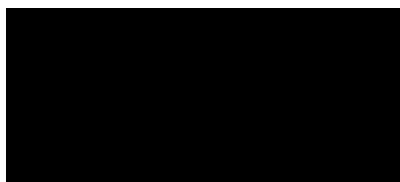

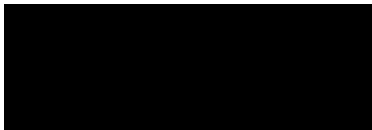

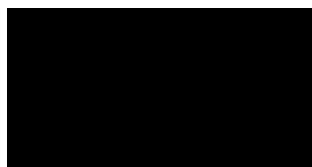

We would ask that when looking at proposals for the ward you would keep in mind that all White City residents, from both sides of Finlay Road are considered as part of the White City area and we would consider it vital that this community is kept in one ward, i.e. Matson and Robinswood. We have heard that there are proposals to split this community and would ask that you do not accept any proposal to split the community of White City that has worked so hard to be recognised as a community and have recently had street signs erected for White City.
