Dear Sir,

Thank you for your invitation to comment on the Electoral Review of Lancaster. Can I ask that you ignore my original submission because it is now clear what it is about.

Looking at the figures of the average electorate per councillor, based on a council comprising of 60 councillors, we appear to have the correct balance. No change is necessary for my ward and the adjacent wards - Bare, Torrisholme, Poulton, and Slyne-with-Hest. They are all appropriately named identified areas with long standing local communities/Parishes. If a finer balance is required the Post Code (made up of 5 to 10 properties) could be used to make adjustments. I can see no reason to change the electoral arrangements for my ward, but the exercise has been useful to confirm I am being fairly represented.
