Attached is a proposal for rewarding of Quedgeley Parish Council

- **Quedgeley Severn Vale - 5 Parish Councillors**
- **Quedgeley Fieldcourt – 5 Parish Councillors**
- **Quedgeley Daniels Brook - 3 Parish Councillors**
- **Quedgeley Kingsway – 3 Parish Councillors**

It has not been possible to achieve four wards with four parish councillors in each ward. The numbers just don't balance without creating some very inconvenient boundaries. The number of electors per Councillor has been maintained.

It is anticipated that as Kingsway grows, by the time of the next boundary review it will be possible to have four wards with four councillors in each based upon this configuration.

**Quedgeley Severn Vale** is almost identical to the existing ward and the City Council proposal. Some minor relocation of property which is physically located in the adjacent wards has been undertaken.

**Quedgeley Fieldcourt** is very similar to the existing Fieldcourt ward, but without Copeland Park and Kingsway. This proposal is almost identical to the City Council proposal for Quedgeley Central. The name Quedgeley Central is rejected in favour of the existing name Quedgeley Fieldcourt. Some minor relocation of property which is physically located in the adjacent wards has been undertaken.

The wards of Quedgeley Severnvale and Quedgeley Fieldcourt are similar in size in terms of population, with FIVE Parish Councillors per ward.

Both wards are entirely located west of the A38 dual carriageway.

**Quedgeley Daniels Brook** includes all the area GCC proposes as Quedgeley Brook plus almost half the Kingsway estate. Quedgeley Brook is not a preferred name – this proposal is to use the title Quedgeley Daniels Brook. This ward proposal encompasses all the existing dwellings that border the Daniels Brook corridor.

**Quedgeley Kingsway** is based upon the GCC proposal entitled Quedgeley Fieldcourt. This physical location has several hundred metres remote from the Fieldcourt area of Quedgeley. The area has become widely known as Quedgeley Kingsway and it is proposed to retain this name.

The wards of Quedgeley Daniels Brook and Quedgeley Kingsway are similar in size in terms of population, with THREE Parish Councillors per ward.

Both wards are entirely located east of the A38 dual carriageway.

The location of boundaries, and which street to put into which ward, was selected first on natural community boundaries, second proximity to established polling stations, third on the need to balance the relative populations of each ward.

Better late than never – here's hoping they accept it
