Comment text:

I am a resident of the coastal parish of Beeston Regis which is currently in the Chaucer ward of North Norfolk District Council – apart from Upper Sheringham all of the other parishes in the Chaucer ward are sparsely populated inland rural parishes. In my opinion Beeston Regis should be aligned with Sheringham to the west of Beeston Regis which many regard as an urban extension of Sheringham . Most of the residents live in two settlements only separated from Sheringham by Beeston Regis Common and Beeston Regis Back Common (both of which are within Sheringham Town council area). In a recent Beeston Regis Parish Questionnaire when asked “ Do you consider that you live in a village or tend to view Beeston Regis as a suburb of Sheringham” 204 out of 293 (70%) responded that they tended to view Beeston Regis as a suburb of Sheringham. The majority of residents have a Sheringham post code. The majority are registered with Sheringham Medical Centre which is less than a mile away. The town centre of Sheringham is easily accessible where it provides a Post office, main line railway station, theatre, supermarket, public houses, restaurants, cafes and shops of every description . Most children in Beeston Regis attend the primary , secondary and sixth form schools in Sheringham. Whilst Beeston Regis has an Anglican Church the nearest Methodist, Baptist and Roman Catholic churches are in Sheringham . Beeston Regis is policed by the Sheringham team of constables and PCSO’s .Beeston Regis Parish Council is represented on the Sheringham Safer Neighborhood Scheme and the Sheringham Society. I believe From a democratic point of view Beeston Regis will be better served by being part of a ward which includes Sheringham.
