We welcome the creation of a two member ward for Holmes Chapel, Cranage, Goostrey and Twemlow as proposed. However, we consider that the proposed designation as "Holmes Chapel Ward" is a misnomer which would alienate the residents of Cranage, Goostrey, and Twemlow. We would much prefer a more inclusive name such as "Dane Valley Ward".

We also accept the proposed new single member ward comprising the remainder of the present Congleton Rural Ward. However, we have reservations regarding the proposed designation as "Brereton Ward" for the same reasons and envisage that you will receive further submissions from the various parish councils affected.
