CHESHIRE EAST ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS

Having examined and discussed your Draft Recommendations for New Electoral Arrangements for Cheshire East Council in relation to Macclesfield Constituency, Macclesfield Constituency Conservative Association is generally in agreement with your proposals except four detailed ward boundary issues and four ward names for which we set out below preferred alternatives.

1. Lyme Handley Parish to be part of Disley Ward, not Poynton East and Pott Shrigley, because of historic associations and road communications with Disley.
2. Kettleshulme Parish to be part of Sutton Ward, not Poynton East and Pott Shrigley, because consequent on the last proposal Kettleshulme would be isolated from Poynton East and Pott Shrigley.
3. Lyme Green to be part of Macclesfield Moss Ward, not Sutton, because development along main London Road from Macclesfield Moss Ward is continuous out to Lyme Green.
4. Adlington Parish to be part of Poynton East and Pott Shrigley Ward, not Poynton West and Adlington, because the nature of Adlington is more similar to Poynton East and Pott Shrigley in respect of the rural content, and the presence of another Parish Council.
5. If the last proposal is accepted, Poynton West and Adlington Ward to be renamed Poynton West Ward, for self evident reason.
6. Renaming of Broken Cross and Upton Priory Ward to Broken Cross and Upton Ward, because Upton is the historic name of the hamlet stretching along Prestbury Road, Macclesfield, from the historic Grade 2 star Listed Whitfield House towards the SE end (for which deeds and other documents include Upton in the address), past Upton Cottage to Upton Hall and Upton Hall Farm at the NW end, all of which still exist; a number of long established residents along the length of Prestbury Road still use Upton as part of their postal address. The suffix Priory applies only to relatively recent development at the NW end of Prestbury Road.
7. Renaming of Macclesfield Moss Ward to Macclesfield South Ward because the name Moss applies only to part of the Ward and would seem to exclude a significant majority of residents in the Ward.
8. Renaming of Macclesfield Weston and Ivy Ward to Macclesfield West and Ivy Ward because the name Weston applies only to part of the Ward and would seem to exclude a significant majority of residents in the Ward.
