Regarding the submission of proposed Electoral Division arrangements for Buckinghamshire, and your agreement with Clive Parker to allow a County Council response to be submitted following today's Council (21st April), this e-mail is to confirm the County Councils submission to the Local Government Boundary Commission.

With the exception of the two attached amendments and the point raised by the liberal democrats (see note below), please use the 'Buckinghamshire County Council Conservative Group proposals for the review of the internal boundaries to create 49 Divisions for 49 Councillors' (sent on 1st April) as the County Councils submission for the proposed boundaries.

The County Council wishes you to note that the Liberal Democrats voted against the proposal and it was not a unanimous County Council decision.

When you open the attached PDF file you will find two small amendments - one relating to a name change in the Chiltern area which clarifies the division better and the other amendment is in order to take one individual close from one division and to put into the next division because currently it is being split off from its natural community and is left in isolation. This only involves moving 22 electors across, it will not make any major changes to the variances of each division and it is merely putting something right and makes pragmatic sense.
