Feedback: Noting that the proposed reduction from 57 to 49 county councillors in Buckinghamshire should produce an annual saving of £100,000 I have written to the local press (Buckinghamshire Examiner) about the effect of setting the division size at the national average of 8,800 voters. This would offer a further reduction to 43 councillors, which proportionately should offer a further saving of £75,00 annually - a sum significantly equal to the cost of maintaining full street lighting in the county.
