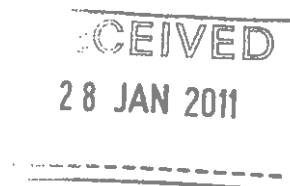

Dear Sir,



I refer to your recent consultation letter of 11th January 2011 setting out the progress of the review of Bucks County Council areas and inviting comments on the same.

Westcott Parish Council has considered this matter and wishes to advise that the village of Westcott identifies itself much more with Waddesdon than with any villages within its existing ward of Bernwood. The reasons are that there is no association with any village in the Bernwood ward but does have the following with Waddesdon:

1. Waddesdon is only two miles from Westcott
2. Westcott is in the catchment area of the Waddesdon schools
3. Waddesdon has a village shop used by many of Westcott's residents
4. Waddesdon is Westcott's local Post Office
5. Westcott is in the ecclesiastical parish of Waddesdon
6. Policing in Westcott is covered from Waddesdon Police Station.
7. There are bus services from Westcott to Waddesdon
8. Waddesdon has four village pubs used by Westcott residents - Westcott lost its only pub a few years ago
9. Waddesdon has good play facilities for children and teenagers which are used by Westcott's young people.
10. Westcott adjoins Waddesdon Manor, one of Bucks major tourist attractions
11. The Waddesdon monthly village newsletter carries Westcott's news items and Parish Council news
12. Three local charities combine Westcott with Waddesdon.
13. Waddesdon operates a weekly Day Centre for the elderly which is used and enjoyed by Westcott residents.

I trust you will take the above comments into consideration as part of the review.
