Dear Boundary Commission

BUCKINGHAMSHIRE REVIEW

The County Council has considered its response to the Commission's latest consultation on the Buckinghamshire Review.

You will be aware of the County Council's formal position communicated to you in April.

The Council's comments on your proposals are as follows:-

The County Council supports the Marlow Town Council's view that all voters living on the west of Glade Road, between Little Marlow Road and Claremont Road, Marlow, be included within the Marlow Town South ward and the Marlow Electoral Division for County Council purposes.

The County Council would prefer Swanbourne, Mursley, Dunton and Hoggston with the Winslow Division like it was prior to the last Boundary change in 2005. Thornborough naturally links with North Buckingham Division as all villages in this Division are north of the A421, which is a main trunk road. Granborough sits better with North Marston, Pitchcott and Oving which are all west of the primary A413 road – part of Great Brickhill Division. The opinion of the Local Member is that Granborough has no affinity with the town of Winslow.

I would also like to draw your attention to a couple of typing errors in your Report both on page 12. In the third line of para 66, it should read Newtown and not Newton. In the second line of para 69, Chalfont should read Chalfont Common.
