## Re: Electoral Review of Buckinghamshire

A summary of the Local Government Boundary Commission for England's proposals for Buckinghamshire County Council was circulated to all District Councillors for comment. Timescales did not allow for the matter to be considered at Full Council, however, the comments received from District Councillors are summarised below:

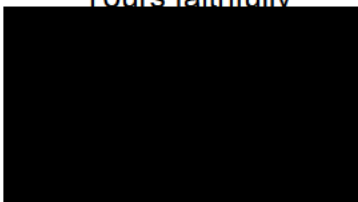
- Two Councillors representing wards in Chalfont St Peter endorsed the LGBC's proposed Chalfont St Peter division as a positive improvement to that suggested by the County Council.
- One Councillor expressed disappointment that Chesham had been casually divided into three, suggesting that it should have been left intact with two Chesham urban members. It was added that the villages around Chesham are determinedly separate parishes and have maintained over many years that they were 'not Chesham'.

The following errors have also been noted in the report pertaining to Chiltern:

- Paragraph 66 – should refer to 'Newtown', not 'Newton'
- Paragraph 69 – should refer to 'the two villages of Chalfont St Peter and Chalfont **Common**'.

No further comments were received.
