*New Marlow South East Parish Ward*

The Marlow Society wishes to add its support to the comments of our member Mr. Derek Done in his letter to you of the 26<sup>th</sup> September 2011 on the above subject.

The members of this Society are well aware of the proposal to create a Marlow South East Parish Ward which would be incorporated with Flackwell Heath in a new County Electoral Division, and have asked me to convey to you that they too are concerned at this change. They are deeply concerned that, for those people that live in this part of Marlow, this will weaken their effective representation at County level and will further disturb the natural local community identification with Marlow and its immediate environs.
