Comment/enquiry type: relating to a current review
Comments: Although a parish councillor in Blackwater & Hawley, I am resident in Fleet (both within Hart D C). As Hart is steadily growing, it's number of councillors should be increasing to at least ensure numerical parity with neighbouring authorities eg. Rushmoor. However Hart is growing far faster than Rushmoor therefore a degree of anticipated future growth should be incorporated. All things considered, Hart's councillors should equal 42 (as presently in Rushmoor) to provide for our needs with 39 as an absolute minimum. Under no circumstances can Hart's current number of council seats be reduced. Although undoubtedly attractive for urban areas, rural seats can span very wide areas if established upon a multi-member basis however this can be alleviated by attaching a rural area to an adjacent urban area where possible to do so.
