Dear Sir/Madam,

I refer to your review of boundaries notice displayed in the Parish of **Kings Sutton Northamptonshire**.

The County Councillor representing this area of Northamptonshire lives well away from the district represented.

At the last Local Government election so little interest was shown that the DISTRICT Councillor was returned unopposed.

Both the present District and County Councillors live, in my opinion, too far from the areas they represent. It may be that there would be more interest shown if they were obliged by law to live within the area they wish to stand for.

Even less interest is shown in the Parish Council which has vacancies for 15 councillors, too many in my opinion. Co-option is often resorted to and no election was held on the last occasion.

It may well be that as this Parish is so close to the Oxfordshire border, (nearest town Banbury) that more interest might be shown in that direction, The River Cherwell being the County Boundary.

I hope these views have some use to your review.
