Comments on optimum council size (currently 80) – Ends November 22nd 2010

This was an agenda item at the meeting of the full Council on 15th November 2010 which Cllr. Helyn Clack (Dorking Rural) also attended. Cllr. Hazel Watson (Dorking Hills) was unable to attend but had discussed the matter with Cllr. Clack in advance.
