Comments: An injustice now exists within the Parish of GODSTONE in Surrey. The Parish consists of three villages, Godstone(North Ward), South

Godstone (Central) & Blindley Heath(south)

There are 5 elected Councillors allocated to Godstone but only 2 to each of the other two villages.

The total electors of both South Godstone & Blindley Heath exceed that of Godstone but the proportion of Parish Councillors is less, equally the amount of Council Tax paid is more for South Godstone & Blindley Heath together than Godstone. A change in the amount of Councillors should be applied where Godstone has 3 Councillors not 5 and the other two villages retain 2 each. Then when a vote has to be applied a more proportionate balance would exist.
