Please find below a submission from Horne Parish Council

The PC understands that the optimum number of people to be represented is 10,000 maximum. Lingfield Division is 19% above this. At present it is made up of the Parish Councils of Horne, Outwood, Felbridge, Lingfield, Dormansland, Crowhurst, Samllfield and Burstow. The PC feels that the boundaries should be made by the movement of the population so would propose that Smallfield and Burstow be taken out of the Lingfield Division as the majority of these residents tend to go westwards to Horley and possibly Redhill. It is worth noting that Nutfield Division only has 8000 people.

Tandridge should have 2 to 3 more County Councillors to get the representation needed in this review.
