**Subject:** Surrey - Caterham Valley Division and Woldingham

In your consideration of divisional boundaries in Surrey, please take account of my strong objection to Surrey County Council's recommendation that Woldingham should be moved from the Caterham Valley Division and brigaded with Warlingham instead.

This would ride rough-shod over the opinion of our present divisional Councillor; would break our well established links with Caterham as regards education, transport and planning matters among other things; and would force the representation of this rural village into the same division as a more populous suburban area on the fringe of Croydon and the London conurbation with which we do not have much in common. The argument about evening up numbers is less important to many of us here than the Commission's other key points about ensuring strong community ties and the natural boundaries between communities: the steep valley between Woldingham and **Warlingham** is a clear natural boundary between us, and the differences in scale and interests of our separate communities make it totally inappropriate for us to be represented together.
