Comment text:

Pitsea South East is too large and has a massively diverse range of housing and estates, from small villages to huge urban estates. It also includes parts which should clearly be in Vange. I'd suggest having a 'North Benfleet and Bowers Gifford' ward separate from the remaining estates and urban areas of Pitsea and Vange. Lee Chapel North has a distinct split between areas which consider themselves 'Basildon' and areas which consider themselves 'Laindon'. This means that some issues affect parts of the ward but not others. Splitting that ward into the Basildon and Laindon sides, possibly adding the Laindon side into the St Nicholas part of Laindon Park and the Basildon side into the Gloucester Park development. Crouch doesn't seem to have an identity in itself, it's just the leftover bits of North of the A127 cobbled together. Much of these areas could be divided up across the Burstead and Wickford Castledon wards, leaving a Noak Bridge ward which straddles the A127 and covers parts of Laindon Park in the Basildon Drive and Church Hill area. The Long Riding section of St Martins also fits better with Vange as, like with Lee Chapel North, this area identifies more with Pitsea and Vange than it does with Basildon centre.
