In general, it's the number of Councillors per 100 people that should be the same allocation across all the Wards: given modern physical and electronic communications, geographic area should be a subsidiary consideration "at the margins" of decisions. In terms of details: - The "U-shaped" dip in Culverden ward down to the station should be eliminated and the Southern Boundary continue straight along Church Road instead of its right-angle turn downwards. Reason: the inhabitants, of whom I am one in TN1, use the High Street area and into the Pantiles much more than up into residential Culverden Down. We need to have our say with a Councillor covering that area- Pantiles and St Mark's. -The southerly "kink" southwards at the bottom of Grove Hill Road looks odd given the connection between the streets involved which have access to the Grove rather than Calverley Gardens and the residents there that I know care more about the Grove which currently has different Councillors in Pantiles and St Mark's from their own in Park.
