### Comment text:

Waltham Abbey is a separate, but integral part of Epping Forest District. It consists of two parts - one rural (High Beach) and one urban. The rural part forms an essential buffer between the urban area and other urban areas - Epping to the East, Loughton and Buckhurst Hill to South East, and London (Chingford) to the South. The West is bounded by the River Lee and Lee Navigation. The two parts compliment each other and are linked parochially. Although The commission wants 3 member wards, I think High Beach is an exception. I would propose that Waltham Abbey be allocated 9 members - a reduction of one. That could be three 3 member wards, one of which is split into a 2 member and 1 member sub-ward. The latter would be High Beach. Thus, the Commission's principle is maintained, whilst maintaining the current arrangement.
