we have lived on [REDACTED] Road, Spital, for over 60 years and local residents identify as a community with the residents of Hady. There is a direct link from the top of Valley Road to Hady via the school path and the fields and woodland - these are popular areas for dog walkers and residents from both Spital & Hady socialise in these areas. For this reason we feel that Hady should be in the same ward as Spital - to keep that sense of community - Spital does not have community links with the Riverside estate, let alone the areas on the other side of the town centre. Primary school children from Spital & Hady attend Hady Primary School, both areas are in the Church of England Parish of St Mary's & All Saints Church (The Crooked Spire) and residents from both Hady & Spital identify with the town centre, with a bus route running through both areas to & from the town (as well as direct walking routes). Therefore, we feel that Hady should remain in the same ward as Spital along with the town centre, so that Spital does not become isolated within the new ward. [REDACTED]
