Comment text:

I am a resident of [REDACTED] Road in Spital and would like to oppose the proposal regarding Spire Ward in your consultation document. I believe that Hady and Spital should remain in the same ward as there are close links between the two communities. Local primary age children all go to the same school and there are safe footpaths linking the two communities that enable this. There is a large playing field adjacent to the school that is used by both communities, and a safe footpath to the park in Spital - also enjoyed by both communities together with the football pitch. Residents in Spital do not identify with the community in Hasland. The town centre is nearer for shopping and easy to walk to. We have a Co-op in Spital which is also used by the residents in Hady as it is easy and safe to walk to. The shops in Hasland can only be accessed by walking along a busy road as there is no direct bus route between the two. Both Hady and Spital are in the parish of St Mary's and all Saints. Residents from both communities socialise through the school, local walks and the Riverside Club which bisects both communities. I therefore think that Hady and Spital should remain together in the town centre ward and not be attached to Hasland where there are no community links.
