## Currently there are:

- 90 councillors
- 30 wards
- Three councillors per ward

A public consultation is open until 8 June 2022

We aim to make sure Liverpool councillors represent a similar number of electors


## Currently there are:

- Nine wards that are more than 10\% away from the average number of electors per ward
- One ward that is more than $30 \%$ away from the average


## We are proposing:

- 85 councillors
- 71 wards
- One three-councillor ward, 12 two-councillor wards, \& 58 single-councillor wards



## Our proposals mean that:

- One ward will be more than 10\% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor will represent an average of 4,300 electors
