
Currently there are:

- 39 councillors
- 18 wards
- 6 three-councillor wards, 9 two-councillor wards and 3 single-councilor wards

A public consultation is open until **I | April 2022**

We are proposing:

- 36 councillors
- 17 wards
- 3 three-councillor wards, 13 two-councillor wards and 1 single-councilor ward



Our proposals mean that:

- No wards will be more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor will represent an average of 2,344 electors



We aim to make sure Blaby councillors represent a similar number of electors



Currently there are:

 4 wards that are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
