## Currently there are:

- 39 councillors
- 18 wards
- 6 three-councillor wards, 9 two-councillor wards and 3 single-councillor wards

37 residents and organisations helped shape our recommendations

We aim to make sure Blaby councillors represent a similar number of electors


## Currently there are:

- 5 wards that are more than $10 \%$ away from the average number of electors per ward


## From elections in 2023:

- 36 councillors
- 17 wards
- 3 three-councillor wards, I3 two-councillor wards and I single-councillor ward


Blaby will move towards:

- No wards being more than 10\% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor representing an average of 2,344 electors
