## NEW ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS

## Currently there are:

- 60 councillors
- 27 wards
- 12 three-councillor wards, nine two-councillor wards, six onecouncillor wards

A public consultation is open until 23 November 202I


We aim to make sure Lancaster councillors represent a similar number of electors


## Currently there are:

- Eight wards that are more than
$10 \%$ away from the average number of electors per ward
- Two wards that are more than
$30 \%$ away from the average


## We are proposing:

- 60 councillors
- 25 wards
- 15 three-councillor wards, five two-councillor wards and five single-councillor wards


Our proposals mean that:

- One ward will be more than 10\% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor will represent an average of I,879 electors
