Currently there are:

- 60 councillors
- 27 wards
- 12 three-councillor wards, 9 two-councillor wards and 6 single-councillor wards

We aim to make sure Lancaster councillors represent a similar

number of electors



Currently there are:

- 8 wards that are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- 2 wards that are more than 30% away from the average

From elections in 2023:

- 61 councillors
- 27 wards
- II three-councillor wards, I2 two-councillor wards and 4 single-councillor wards



Lancaster will move towards:

- 2 wards being more than
 10% away from the average
 number of electors per ward
- Each councillor representing an average of 1,848 electors
