
Currently there are:

- 29 councillors
- 12 wards
- 5 three-councillor wards and
 7 two-councillor wards

A public consultation is open until **10 October 2022**

We are proposing:

- 27 councillors
- 9 wards
- 9 three-councillor wards



Our proposals mean that:

- No wards will be more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor will represent an average of 2,402 electors

We aim to make sure Redditch councillors represent a similar number of electors

 No wards that are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
