We aim to make sure Waverley councillors represent a similar number of electors




Currently there are:

 Seven wards that are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward

From elections in 2023:

- 50 councillors
- 24 wards
- Five three-councillor wards, 16 two-councillor wards & three one-councillor wards



2027 will move towards:

- One ward being more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor representing an average of 2,106 electors
