Comment text:

The Hitcham and Taplow Society submits as follows: The Society has been in existence for some sixty years. It has a main objective to ensure that all development within the district is of the highest standard and preserves the quality of the environment. It represents a significant proportion of the residents of Taplow. The Society fully supports the submission below made by Taplow Parish Council in which they propose that a single councillor ward for Taplow and Dorney would be a much better representation of the area than being merged into and overwhelmed by the larger Burnham ward. "Taplow Parish Council submits the following response to the consultation over changes to electoral wards within Buckinghamshire. We believe that the rural Taplow & Dorney parishes are sufficiently distinct from the more urban areas of Burnham that it is presently proposed to merge them with that an alternative should be implemented. Our interests will be better served with a single councillor ward for Taplow and Dorney, with Burnham Lent Rise being re-joined with Burnham Church and Beeches to again form a more integrated ward. We note that several such single councillor wards are already proposed at Sands and Downley wards in the High Wycombe area".
