7 Dials, St Peter's, N. Laine/Round Hill: Having a boundary which splits London Road down the middle lengthways would be unhelpful in two ways. 1. This is a shopping area and both sides of London Road are homogenous. The interests and concerns are the same and I wonder what the benefit would be of having different councillors representing each side. 2. Having a boundary that cuts off the Level from London Road could be unhelpful. The issues and problems of The Level spill onto London Road and the area going up to Brighton Station i.e. Providence Place, Elder Place, St Peter's Street and the New England Quarter. There therefore would be a danger of having 5 or 6 councillors representing adjoining new wards with neither taking responsibility for holding necessary meetings and carrying out actions required.
