## **Boundary Commission changes**

I write as a resident of Alfrick Pound who is involved with the village community shop and the village show.

The villages of Alfrick and Lulsley have been linked for generations and I don't think they should be split for election purposes. There are numerous bodies which carry the name of both villages:

Alfrick and Lulsley Parish Council  
Alfrick and Lulsley Show  
Alfrick and Lulsley Community Shop  
Alfrick and Lulsley Tennis Club  
Alfrick and Lulsley Parochial Church Council  
Alfrick and Lulsley Village Hall  
Alfrick and Lulsley Community Car Scheme

All of these bodies are run by volunteers from across the two villages. We seem to do everything (except educate our children) together.

The two villages share facilities: there is one church, one pub, one village hall, one shop, one tennis court; the bus service serves both villages (as well as Leigh and Bransford).

To split Lulsley off to the Martley ward would isolate Lulsley. It will be cut off (quite literally at times) from the rest of the ward by the River Teme.

I can see from the map that the current ward has to be reduced and would suggest that it would be more sensible (though not ideal) to keep Alfrick and Lulsley together, and also to keep Leigh, Leigh Sinton and Bransford together, so maybe the boundary should be between Alfrick and Leigh. It should not be between Alfrick and Lulsley.
