At the moment, Buckinghamshire Council is the largest council in the country with over 20 Councillors more than the next largest. It is also considerably bigger than the Scottish Parliament, with each councillor costing residents at least £13,000 a year.

Having 147 councillors is completely unnecessary and only slows down decision making without increasing representation for local residents.

At a time when Aylesbury residents are recovering from the pandemic and the government is increasing taxes on families and small businesses, we must reduce waste at Buckinghamshire Council.

A reduction in the number of councillors from 147 to under 100, would save at least £600,000 a year.
