Comment text:

We need fewer than 100 councillors, ideally 80-98, each representing single-seat wards and paid appropriately to allow them to live entirely off their stipend if necessary and therefore devote most or all of their time to their council responsibilities. Too many councillors under the present system do nothing much, relying on colleagues in 3-seat wards to carry the load, but still earning a respectable stipend. Current stipends are too low to allow enough people of working age to stand for election, so the council is skewed towards retirees. 80 single-ward councillors would allow every community of 5,000 voters to have their own, local, councillor.
