I am glad that we maintain two councillors. However, in view of the fact that we will be impacted significantly by the major developments being proposed around here, I query whether the forecast electorate is not being underestimated. In addition, with the major developments taking place close by in Broadheath, I wonder whether our interests and concerns are not more allied with theirs, rather than Alfrick and Leigh which for the present at least would appear to remain more rural in nature. After all, much of the little and inadequate infrastructure that there is, such as the junior school and medical centre will be more likely shared with them. Hence, Rushwick and Broadheath will have more mutual interests and face similar issues . Of course, if we did combine with Broadheath we would most likely require more than two councillors. Because of the major developments taking place, sadly, Rushwick is almost inevitably going to become suburban, rather than semi-rural as it is at present, and this might be another reason why we should be combined with Broadheath as again, like them, our concerns and interests are likely to be less rural and more 'town' or even Worcester city facing.
