Comment text:

My ward Broadheath is currently one of the largest wards in Trafford. The section I live in around Deansgate Lane is a small patch of the ward that falls on the Timperley/Altrincham side of the canal/railway, whereas the rest of the ward is located on the other side. This section is cut off from the rest of the ward by the canal/railway but also by the A56 Manchester Road. Given that this ward is one that presumably needs to be reduced, would it make more sense for this section to be relocated into the Altrincham or Timperley wards with whom there is more neighbourhood connection or even distributed between the 2. Broadheath currently covers a large area from different sections of Trafford from the edge of the Racecourse estate in Sale to the outskirts of Timperley/Altrincham so has quite disparate communities within it and so is currently quite a large geographical area as well as large in terms of constituent numbers making it more difficult for the 3 councillors to represent the whole ward effectively
