Why reduce the number of Councillors by only 5? Most wards are "bloated" with too many councillors. This not only increases unnecessary bureaucracy but also compromises personal accountability. A better solution would be to have one councillor per Ward, accompanied with a staff team of two in support. I agree that there are too many wards and too much annual electioneering distracting councillors and staff. Regarding the reconfiguration of ward boundaries, I doubt that there will ever be a solution that works for everyone. However, in saying this, greater consideration needs to be given to co-terminosity with other statutory bodies, ie, police, fire, health in particular - primary care). This consultation will never be able to accommodate the diverse range of views likely to be submitted by the public. I would therefore, suggest a more strategic approach based on need and opportunity.
