Re: Boundary Commission submission for Dothill and Shawburch Wards in Telford & Wrekin

I have lived in Dothill for over 50 years and wish to support Dothill and Shawburch being made into 1 Ward with 2 Councillors.

There are many practical reasons to support joining Dothill and Shawburch and I am stating some of them below.

One of the reasons are the schools in the area. Dothill Primary school has children from Dothill and Shawburch attending the school.

Senior school placement is at Charlton School. This school is sited in Dothill but children from Dothill and Shawburch attend as there is no senior school in Shawburch. There is safe, well-established paths and roads that allow Shawburch schoolchildren to walk safely to school in Dothill.

Shawburch has a well-established Medical Practice that is currently being rebuilt on a much larger site with extensive improved facilities. Residents in Dothill have no medical practice and share the Shawburch Practice.

There are road and footpath links between the areas. It is easy for Dothill residents to walk to the Shawburch Medical Practice and chemist. Dothill also has no chemist.

There is a beautiful nature reserve and pools at Dothill. It is on the edge of Shawburch and most people would be unable to show where Dothill and Shawburch meet.

There is true beauty here and is another reason to support community cohesion for Dothill and Shawburch residents.
