



I think the wards are too large which makes it very difficult to know which councillor to contact and to deliver electoral accountability. We live at the extreme SW end of the East Brighton ward in quite a different demographic to Donald Hall Rd, Manor and Craven Vale areas. These latter 3 do appear to have a more coherent whole despite the physical separation of Craven Vale. It strikes me that East Brighton ward would be better split into 3, Coastal section, Manor, Craven Vale and Donald Hall Rd areas (most of which were excluded from Eb4U due to them being seen as a coherent whole more suited to other funding) and Whitehawk. There are sections of Whitehawk at the bottom which are more closely linked to the coastal strip than the main section further up the hill beyond the bus garage such that this would be a convenient place to split the boundaries to even up numbers.
