

Comment text:

I believe that the Newport south parish boundary should be brought in line with the borough boundary along the A518 between Newport and Chetwyned Aston & Woodcote. People currently living in this location and indeed the 370+ additional dwellings due to be erected in the coming 12-18months along Station Rd (opposite Wright Ave) feel apart of the Newport community. They enjoy the services and security that Newport Town Council provides these residents whilst they currently live outside of the parish ward boundary. With extra housing comes with added challenges that we must face as a community, made demonstrably easier with the funding to do so. Any funding from the new development along Station Rd would be picked up by the adjacent parish of Chetwynd Aston & Woodcote, a parish that provide no services of note to it's residents, many of whom feel apart of the Newport community regardless. From a democratic point of view, it would also make sense to align the parish and borough boundaries so that residents who feel that they live in Newport and take advantage of the services the council provides are not confused when it comes to electing candidates who are best placed to represent them locally at parish and borough level. With the additional projected electors moving into this area once the development(s) are finished, I believe that the current amount of two borough councillors is sufficient.
