Dear Sirs,

The Metropolitan Borough of Trafford has submitted its recommendations for changes to the boundaries of wards within the Borough and I write in support of these proposals.

The changes proposed are consistent with the technical requirements set out by the Commission, but most importantly of all reflect community links and ties as well as the road, rail and natural boundaries which defines the local area.

In my own constituency of Altrincham and Sale West the Trafford Conservative proposals create clearer definitions for the wards, address the community ties and where possible reunite areas of the borough.

The submission seeks to reflect the community's views by reuniting areas of Timperley, respects the residents and communities' views of where their local amenities are in Hale Central ward and observes historic links in Ashton upon Mersey and St Mary's wards.

Accordingly, I ask that these plans are considered favourably by the Commission as it finalises its own proposals for public consultation.
