Dear Sirs

I am writing to you on behalf of Sheering Parish Council to object to the proposed three councillor ward of Rural East.

Rural East is a very difficult area as it includes the suburban area of Lower Sheering. The rest of Rural east IS rural; Lower Sheering is not. It is, on the one hand, a dormitory area for people travelling from Sawbridgeworth station to London on the other, it has the potential to be swallowed up into the East Harlow development and to become part of a much larger development.

It has already lost its identity and people are desperately searching for a community such as that found in Sheering Village.

Issues throughout the villages in the rural areas are similar - fly tipping, speeding, issues with Essex highways, potholes, undergrowth, activities for communities etc.; general issues which can be dealt with by two councillors familiar with those points.

Lower Sheering is different, we therefore feel that to best serve the residents of the ward of Lower Sheering a dedicated councillor would be a more suitable arrangement.
