As a resident of Coalway Road for over 30 years, I found it absolutely disgraceful how the new wards show most of Coalway Road as part of Graislely. In the decades I have resided here, we have rarely if ever had the need to go into Graislely and out local establishments which we use including takeaways, convenience stores and schools are all within Pennn. It is against common sense to have a border which does not include the whole road within the geographic boundaries of the area which it has always been associated with. To have a road which has property prices which coincide with the other houses in the area suddenly change wards to belong to an area with properties of a noticeable smaller and more economical size is most likely to have been decided to balance out the average earning stats to show Wolverhampton council has done much work to alleviate the average household income in some poorer wards like Graiseley. Our family have purposely bought a house in Penn partly because of the status and the neighbourly green feeling of the Penn area. We've worked as a family for decades to pay the mortgage of our house to now be told that this is no longer to count as the rightful area of Penn.
